Signing up to assist with UHI research surveys.

Your information will be used for the following purposes:

UHI researchers often undertake research that includes surveys. In many cases it is helpful for researchers to be able to send such surveys to students. Your information will be used by the UHI helpdesk to send these survey links to you. Even if you sign up for this there is no obligation on you to complete the surveys. The only data used in this process is your name and UHI email address.

Our legal reason for using the data is;

Your data will, or may, be shared with the following recipients or categories of recipient:

When administering sending you these surveys none of your data is sent outwith UHI. Researchers will only receive your data if you complete the survey. You will always be provided with a privacy notice from the relevant researcher for each survey.

Your data will be retained for the following length of time:

For as long as you are registered as a student with UHI.

The following rights are rights of data subjects:
